

## Instructions for Authors of Invited Plenary Papers – AAAA 2012, Vancouver, Canada

The conference proceedings will be available to all participants on a DVD and will be published on the International Veterinary Information Service [IVIS] web site. This free-of-charge, member-only site can be accessed by veterinarians and others after initial registration.

The format of the invited plenary papers should follow the format used for the journal *Theriogenology* ([www.theriojournal.com](http://www.theriojournal.com)). Please include an abstract, up to six key words (or combination of words/phrases), and number the sections. The suggested **limit is 20 pages double spaced**, including references, figures, and tables. These invited papers will be peer-reviewed, and thus, will **generally not be eligible for subsequent publication in a peer-reviewed journal**. We encourage the authors to make these papers primarily review articles, and to **minimize (or avoid) new, previously unpublished information**.
